## MDP - Narratives

How would you describe the congregation's/organization's specific vision for ministry? How will this vision impact the community? Is the congregation part of a ministry vision or program?

As outlined in our mission statement, we see our mission as that of bringing people to Christ and membership in His Church. We consider ourselves to be a Christ-centered, Bible-based, disciple-making and outreach-oriented church. Christ Centered means that Jesus Christ is our life example, and His work is our life's work. "And He is the head of the body, the Church; He is the beginning and the first born from among the dead, so that in everything He might have the supremacy" (Col 1:18).

Bible Based: Our teaching and our church's mission comes from the Bible, God's inspired word to us. (2 Timothy 3:16-17) "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, that the person of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

Disciple-making: A disciple is a learner who practices spiritual disciplines including prayer, Bible reading, fellowship, and giving. We seek to "make disciples of all nations" (Matt 28:19), "...preparing God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up" (Eph 4:12).

Outreach Oriented: It is our purpose to share Jesus Christ with those who do not yet know him and bring them into the family of God. We live this out in our public witness as a church; being a church in which the gospel is preached. We seek to welcome and serve members of our community – meeting physical needs and inviting people to a knowledge of Jesus.

What is the nature and context of the community in which your congregation lives out its mission/vision? How will you address the emerging needs that are impacting your community?

We feel that people in our community, like much of the country and the world, have a need to be supported in their desires to live faithful Christian lives, and their desires to raise families in the Church. To that end, we want to be a church that welcomes and equips the entire family. We have a culture of volunteering and community engagement that seeks to minister to the spiritual and physical needs of members of our church and broader community.

We partner with other Churches in our town (the Ministerium) towards serving the cause of the gospel and also with groups such as Love INC (Love In the Name of Christ), AA, NA etc. in their work.
